

How do I apply for Financial Aid?

FAFSA on the Web : Hill College recommends that students complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid via the web. This process allows the student to enter new applications or enter renewal applications.

When the Office of Enrollment Management receives the Institutional Student Information Report (ISIR) from the federal processor, a file is considered active. An Enrollment Specialist will review the information reported from the student's application, and send a checklist of documentation that is needed to complete the file. Once a student receives a reply from the federal processor or Hill College, it becomes the student's responsibility to contact the Office of Enrollment Management to complete his/her file.

How do I apply for admission to Hill College? How will I know if I am accepted?

You can apply on line or in person at any campus. The online application is available from the home page of our website; just click on [Apply Online](#). Hill College has an open admission policy. Your application file must be complete (application for admission and all high school or college transcripts received by the college). If you are a transfer student from another college, you must be in good standing. If you do not have a high school diploma or GED, you may still be admitted; just call the Office of Enrollment Management for more information.

How do I register on line?

Once your admission file is complete, you should make an appointment with the Counseling Center to discuss your plans, choose a major, find out who your advisor is and discuss any possible testing requirements. Then most students will be eligible to register online by going through HOOPS, the Hill College Online Orientation Program, to learn how to register.

How do I log in to CampusConnect/My CampusConnect log in is not working

First, have you completed an application for admission and is your file complete? If so, click on CampusConnect. Your student ID is your Hill College ID, or you can use your social security number. Your PIN is your date of birth IN THIS ORDER: 4 digit year, 2 digit month, 2 digit day. Once logged in, you have the option of changing your PIN. If your CampusConnect log in is not working, you may have changed the PIN and forgotten it. You can come by any Enrollment Management office to have it reset to the default or email enrollmentinfo@hillcollege.edu to have it reset.

Do I have to apply to graduate?

Yes! It is not automatic. You must complete the application for graduation by the deadline posted for each semester. You can have your degree or certificate posted to your Hill College semester in August, December or May, but we only have one ceremony in May.

Fill out a [Graduation Application](#) and either scan it and email it to [Brandi Turner](#) or fax it to her attention at 254-659-7604 or bring it to any Enrollment Management Office.

How do I get my grades?

Hill College does not mail out grade reports. Your grades can be viewed on your CampusConnect account as soon as your instructor posts them at the end of the semester.

How do I know how much I will receive in financial aid?

The amount of aid a student receives is based on the information reported on the FAFSA and how many hours the student is enrolled in. Contact an Enrollment Specialist in the Office of Enrollment Management for more information.

I am thinking of transferring to your school, will my financial aid automatically transfer with me?

You will need to go to the FAFSA website at www.fafsa.ed.gov and update your FAFSA to have your information sent to Hill College. The code for the Hillsboro campus is 003573 and the Johnson County campus is E00935. If you are unsure which campus you will attend, use the one for the Hillsboro campus.

How do I request my transcript?

You may request a Hill College transcript either online or in person. Go to the Hill College website and complete a [Transcript Request Form](#). You must not have any “holds” on your account or “owe” the college any transcripts. If you are still in high school, we will send an official transcript to a college or university or scholarship or other agency as a courtesy, but you cannot have one sent to yourself until after you graduate from high school and submit an official, final high school transcript.

How can I view my account to see if I have been awarded any financial aid?

Log on to your CampusConnect account. Once you are in the account, move your cursor on Student Information and then click on Review Financial Aid. Make sure you are in the correct award year. Then press View Aid. This will give you access to your account and will let you view any aid that you have received.

If I fax a transcript from a different college is that considered official?

No, an official transcript must be mailed directly from the college. You can physically bring in the transcript. Make sure that the transcript is in a sealed envelope.

Where do I get a Parking Sticker?

Hillsboro: Go to the Student Housing Office in the Student Center.

Cleburne: Go to the Enrollment Management Office in the Administrative Bldg.
